

## Sundance Stage Lines Non-Discrimination Policy:

Sundance Stage Lines is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation in or denied the benefits of its services on the basis of race, color or national origin, as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended.

Toward this end, it is Sundance's objective to ensure that the level and quality of our transportation service is provided without regard to race, gender, color or national origin. The senior management and all supervisors and employees share the responsibility for carrying out Sundance's commitment to non-discrimination.

Any person who believes that s/he has been subjected to discrimination under Title VI on the basis of race, gender, color or national origin may file a Title VI complaint with Sundance within 180 days from the date of the alleged discrimination. Complaints may either be filed directly with Sundance Stage Lines or with the U.S. Department of Transportation. Complaints may be filed with Sundance by telephone, by e-mail, regular mail or in person during regular business hours.
